Office of Canonical Affairs \$25,000

This office provides ongoing support, development, and direction for our Parishes, Staff, and individual Parishioners who are interacting with our Marriage Tribunal, Sacramental Requirements / Needs, and Canon Law Administration Services.

Youth and Young Adults \$50,000

The future of our Church, Parishes, and our Diocese is predicated on our continued desire to assist in developing new approaches to involve our Youth and Young Adults. With the Pandemic behind us, during this year and next we expect to re engage in activities with the young people to help them find their active role in our Church, now and in the future.



Marriage and Family Life \$25,000

During the last number of years we have experienced continued turbulence in the world, and this has an impact on the life of families and the future of marriage as we know it. That, along with the unique challenges faced by our families emphasizes that support of services such as Rachel's Vineyard and Natural Family Planning is extremely important and needs continued support and encouragement. Also, now with MAiD on our doorstep, we must be vigilant in helping our Catholic families see the message of Jesus in the right to life – from conception to natural death, and all the steps in between.

Catholic Schools \$90,000

With the appointment of our new Superintendent of Schools, Mr. Chris Yuen, we are forging ahead with new plans to help increase the message of faith to our students, and through the students, teachers, and school administrators, to our parents as well. During the 2022 / 2023 school year new investments were made into the Religious Studies programs, and in prayer ministry within the schools, and at home. We expect to continue this new direction, and coordinate with the Youth and Young Adults FIA category to bring new and exciting faith initiatives to our schools and parish communities.



Safe Environment, Human Resources and IT Support \$80,000

During the past 30 months, much effort has been made to update and upgrade the HR and Safe Environment position within the Chancery Office and throughout the Diocese. This continues, along with continual upgrades to our IT Support. Cybersecurity is a critical objective for our Diocese and our Parishioners, and we are undertaking a Diocesan wide project to ensure the safety and security of our Parishioners information.

Pastoral Outreach and Maintenance \$60,000

In the past year, we have been doing some preliminary study and work sorting out needs of some of the smaller parishes and missions of our Diocese; this has taken the form of how to support these smaller communities with administrative and financial reporting, and maintenance of property and buildings so that they may be Doers of Faith into the future. There is much more to be done here, and this support is our Sign of Faith for these communities.



Clergy, Vocations, Seminarians and Permanent Diaconate \$45,000

After some years of prayer, planning, and discernment, Bishop Joseph has authorized that a program of Diaconate Formation begins in our Diocese. This new initiative goes along with our continued care of our clergy in health and welfare benefits, and pension and supplemental retirement benefits. In the past our message has been to address the growing need for a “culture of vocations” in our Diocese, and we anticipate developing this need further through Youth and Young Adults and Catholic Schools initiatives.
